### How it works:

- Each school sends one (or two) team made up of four students
- The emcee then asks a question on foreign affairs, current events, geography, history, people in the news and cultures (The question is also projected on a screen)
- Each team works cooperatively to come up with the correct answer
- The answers are collected and scored by a panel of judges
- The team with the highest score wins

**What happens if you win:** The winning team will have a chance to represent Indiana, their school, and the Indiana Council on World Affairs at the *National Academic WorldQuest Competition* on **April 24, 2010** in Washington, D.C.
