Academic WorldQuest™



Academic WorldQuest is a nationwide World Affairs Councils of America youth education program. Over 5,000 high school students across the US compete in local competitions organized by more than 50 local World Affairs Councils.

For over 15 years ICWA has hosted the Indiana competition. Any Indiana high school (public, charter, private, home school or combination of two schools) can enter teams of four students.

There is no charge to participate in this event. The winning team (four students plus an academic coach) earns a trip to Washington, DC to represent Indiana in the national AWQ competition. ICWA helps fund a large portion of transportation and lodging expenses for the trip.

Each team of four students competes in a quiz-style event that tests students' knowledge of global politics, geography, international economics, history, and world cultures.
